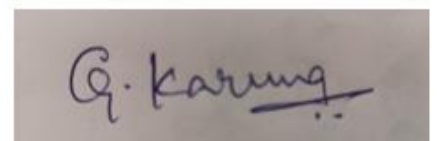

<p><b>Summary of the Event</b></p>	<p>IEEE GRIET TEMS SB organized a seminar under the title “Road map to life work” by Ace Engineering Academy on 5<sup>th</sup> November 2022. The seminar was centric on student’s professional lives. The speaker of the seminar was S. Manimohan Trinath, a trainer at Ace Engineering Academy.</p> <p>In the seminar, the students were first made aware of the importance of trying things they are good at, regardless of the outcomes, they were encouraged by the idea of positive thinking. The speaker explained the importance of aiming for growth when choosing a profession rather than the stipend or CTC offered. The seminar gave clarity and presented world scenarios of companies to the student, along with the necessity for them to develop skills.
